The aim is to offer a wide variety of activities for those who’d like them, whilst allowing the opportunity for those who wish to take plenty of quiet time out to recharge their batteries

The children and young people will have age related activities and those over 8 will have the opportunity to share with the adults in the workshops if they would like to.

About King’s Park

Purpose built, and opened in 1990 by the Queen Mother, it is well placed just 15 minutes from the nearest M1 junction on the northern outskirts of Northampton. As well as the modern residential conference centre, there are two sports centres on site with a wide range of recreational opportunities (not included in the cost of the weekend though!). Wi-fi access is available in an open plan lounge and there are five meeting halls and rooms. Freshly prepared meals have a variety to suit all tastes, and individual dietary requirements notified can be catered for.
